#### Call to Order

David called the regular meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. He introduced guests from the city and from 360 Energy Engineers.

Eileen Horn presented basic information on the \$11,000,000 city-wide energy savings project that is to go before the City Commission on February 7. The library portion of the project includes LED lighting, HVAC control system optimization, and a small amount of weatherization. Estimated payback on the library projects is 2.5 years compared to 18 years for other city-wide projects. The library is responsible for paying the approximate \$65,000 cost of its part of the project, but it can either be paid all at once or rolled into the city financing for the project and paid over time. Joe Hurla and Nick Pederson, 360 Energy Engineers, answered questions from the board. The board asked for additional cost/benefit information on alternate LED options which Joe said he would provide within a week.

### **Public Comment**

There were no public comments.

### Consent Agenda

Judy moved to accept the consent agenda; David seconded. All in favor. Motion carried.

### Director's Report

Brad noted that less was spent from the Capital Improvement fund for the ILS than expected. He highlighted the library's Light Reading program. The program, which provides light therapy lamps to help combat Seasonal Affective Disorder, has been quite popular and has reached a national

media audience. Brad said he was honored to give the graduation address for the Emerging Leaders Academy. He then turned to Kristin, Jenny, and Miriam to talk about the Big Read books and activities for adults, children, and teens. The event kicks off on February 4 with the book giveaway. The capstone of the event is a program featuring Julia Alvarez on March 5 at the Lied Center. Books and brochures highlighting all the activities for each of the three reading age groups were distributed.

### Library Foundation Executive Director's Report

Kathleen said that the current estimate for year to date income is \$309,000, not including funds from the Douglas County Community Foundation. The joint Friends and Foundation annual letter has brought in about \$14,000. Party planning for the After Hours fundraiser continues. Sponsorships totaling \$14,000 have been secured. Fourteen vendors have signed on with food donations. Invitations will go out this week. Tickets can also be purchased online at LPLafterhours.com. The themed basket fundraiser will be back again. Book Clubs around town have created 22 baskets which will be on display February 5 – 11. The Douglas County Genealogical Society has disbanded and given half their money (\$4500) to the library to use for digitization projects. Information Services Coordinator, Melissa Fisher Isaacs, will launch the local online history portal on Kansas Day. The portal features our first digitization project. The Foundation received \$1000 from Walmart for the Seed Library and \$15,000 from the Harrison Family Fund to continue the Music Storytellers series. The Rice Foundation grant request was not approved.

### Friends Report

Sandra said that the annual meeting of the Friends will be on March 6. Nominations for the Mary Murphy Volunteer Award are being accepted. The Friends funded downtown Lawrence gift cards for staff and are planning a luncheon for them on Valentine's Day. CDs don't do well at sales, but Angela has found some other venues to sell them. The Friends have done well enough financially that they will give the library an additional \$30,000 above the \$70,000 already pledged. Membership rates will remain the same for 2017.

The board discussed whether to pay up front for the energy efficiency project or to finance it through the city's bond. Joan moved that the board authorize paying the estimated \$65,000 for the library's portion of the project from the library's capital improvement fund; Brady seconded. Brad will email the board regarding any additional information he receives from 360 Engineers about the project.

### 2017 Organizational Calendar

The board reviewed the 2017 Organizational Calendar. The Strategic Plan for 2018 should be added to March, and the Budget Committee should be formed in February instead of March. Kathleen distributed conflict of interest forms from the auditor.

### The Big Read/Read Across Lawrence 2017

We are now in the midst of Read Across Lawrence for 2017. This year, the library received an NEA grant to participate in The Big Read. This year's pick is Julia Alvarez's *In the Time of the Butterflies*. At our kickoff event, we ran out of over 200 copies of the book in less than a half hour. Events will occur throughout the month and culminate with a free event with Julia Alvarez on Sunday, March 5, at the Lied Center.

In addition, as we have done in the past, we are also doing Read Across Lawrence for kids and teens. The kids' book this year is *Unusual Chickens for the Exceptional Poultry Farmer* by Kelly Jones, and the teen book is *Return to Sender* by Julia Alvarez. We are encouraging high school aged teens to read *In the Time of the Butterflies*. Events complement each of these books for kids and teens as well. Overall, things have been going well thus far. Watch for a wrap up report next month.

### Readers' Advisory Workshop for Kansas Librarians

The library's Book Squad partnered with Northeast Kansas Library System to host a day long workshop for librarians called "Rethink Your RA and Reboot Your Book Club." About 100 librarians convened in our auditorium for a day of learning with RA expert Becky Spratford. Kudos to Polli Kenn and our Readers' Services team for hosting a great continuing education program for librarians in our region.

### **Greyhound Bus Stop Possibly Moving to 7th and Vermont**

The Lawrence stop for the Greyhound bus might possibly move to the corner of 7th and Vermont from its current location in front of City Hall. I offered up the location as a potential site seeing our facility as a good place for people to purchase and print their online ticket, seek shelter, use a restroom, and have a bite to eat. I have received many positive remarks from community members for our 'we serve everyone' approach to this community need. The City Commission and Greyhound will most likely make their determination about the future placement of the bus stop at their March 7 meeting.

### Foundation Director's Report - February 16, 2017

After Hours at the Library. The Carnaval de la Biblioteca was a great success! Approximately 250 people attended the event that celebrated Lawrence Public Library's first ever Big Read. We estimate that the net amount raised was \$34,000, a significant increase over last year's total of \$25,000. Baskets accounted for \$7,900 of the total and \$19,200 came from sponsorships. The event involved coordinating eight Lawrence restaurants, as well as 54 volunteers, LPL staff members, and Foundation Board members. A huge "thank you" goes to the planning committee: Jenny Gorup, Margie Coggins, Mary Gage, Karla Fleming, Craig Penzler, Kim Haig, Kim Rack, Billy Pilgrim, Sheryl Jacobs, Kelly Francis, John Catlin, Eileen Weiss, Gail Vick, and The Agency from KU's Journalism School. Their contributions, energy, and great organizational skills made it all happen.

**Planned Giving Coordinator.** The Foundation is pleased to report that Margie Coggins will serve as its new part time Planned Giving Coordinator. Margie will start work on March 1<sup>st</sup>. She already is drafting a plan to meet with a number of individuals about including the library in their estate plans. Margie is perfect for this position. She not only is a library evangelist, but also has included LPL in her own estate plan.

**Board Vacancies.** Margie Coggins and Laura Denneler will be leaving the Foundation Board after serving the maximum number of years. The board is currently considering nominations for new board members who will start their service at the May meeting.

**New Chapter Society & The Big Read.** Foundation Board members hand delivered copies of Julia Alvarez's *In the Time of the Butterflies* to New Chapter Society members in advance of the Big Read/Read Across Lawrence kick off on February 4<sup>th</sup>. In addition, invitations were mailed to New Chapter Society and board members for a special reception with Julia Alvarez when she visits Lawrence on Sunday, March 5<sup>th</sup>. Look for yours in your mailbox!

### **More Grants and Major Gifts**

- The Harrison Family Fund of DCCF has awarded a \$15,000 grant to the Library Foundation for the 2017 Music Storytellers Series.
- The Blaser Family Fund of DCCF has made a \$10,000 gift to the Library Foundation's general endowment fund at DCCF.
- The Jedel Family Fund of the Greater Kansas City Community Foundation has awarded the Library Foundation a \$2,500 grant for children's and teen's programs.
- The Walmart Foundation has awarded the library a \$1,000 grant for the 2017 seed library.

### **Confidentiality of Records**

The Library is committed to protecting library users' rights to privacy and confidentiality regarding information sought or received at the library.

Customer registration and circulation records are exempt from the Kansas Open Records Law (K.S.A. 45-221 (23)). All customer account information will be used only for legitimate operation of the Library. Disclosure will be limited to the individual account holder and in the case of minors, the responsible adult listed on the account upon presentation of identification.

The library will not disclose personally identifiable information about individual patrons to any requester unless required to do so by law upon receipt of a valid court order or subpoena authorized under federal, state or local law.

#### This information includes:

- The identity of users names, addresses, telephone numbers, ID numbers, or other account details.
- Materials users have borrowed from or through the library.
- Online services used.
- Reference consultations conducted in person, via phone, email, or chat.
- Sign up information for library events or communication.

We will not sell, license or disclose personal information to any third party except an agent working under contract for the library, unless required to do so by law or with the consent of the patron. We will try to contact patrons to reunite them with lost items (found here or elsewhere), but we will never disclose contact information to a third party.

Optional services, like Reading History, which allow the system to retain personal information for the patron's own use, may be provided, but patrons should always be able to opt in or opt out of such service.

Nothing in this statement prevents the Library from exercising its right to enforce rules of behavior, protect its facilities and equipment from harm, or prevent the use of Library facilities and equipment for illegal purposes. Staff is authorized to contact law enforcement authorities and provide information that may identify the individuals perpetrating a crime or a violation of Library use policies.

#### **Use of Facilities**

There is no reasonable expectation of privacy regarding a person's presence in a public building. For that reason, library staff may respond to questions from law enforcement officers about a person's presence in the library. Please note that there is a distinction between privacy of a patron's use of library materials and services and their physical presence in a public building. For example:

- If a law enforcement officer asks staff for information from a patron's library account, or asks if a patron has used the computers, confidentiality procedures apply.
- If a law enforcement officer, who has provided identification, shows staff a picture of a
  patron and asks if the patron has been in the library during a designated time period,
  library staff may answer the officer's inquiry to the best of their ability as the patron has
  no expectation of privacy in this instance.

- Staff may not proactively monitor the library for an individual, regardless of age, and report to law enforcement or any entity when that person comes into the library.
- Staff may not verify one patron's presence in the library to another patron via telephone or in person, regardless of age (e.g. a parent looking for a child). This does not prevent staff from assisting a parent in co-searching for a child.
- In an emergency situation, staff may try to assist in relaying a message to a potential patron when possible, but will not confirm or deny the patron's presence in the library.

### **Video Security Camera Policy**

The Library uses security cameras for the safety and security of library users and staff as well as to protect library assets and operations.

Reasonable efforts will be made to safeguard the privacy of patrons and staff. Cameras are installed in public spaces inside and outside of the Library where patrons have no reasonable expectation of privacy, such as seating areas, stacks, and computer areas. They will not be installed in areas of the Library where individuals have a reasonable expectation of privacy, such as in restrooms.

Access to the footage is restricted to designated staff: Security Guards, Persons-In-Charge, and Information Technology Staff. Viewing should be in staff only areas of the Library to protect patron privacy. Patron access to video footage is not allowed. In situations involving criminal activity, injury, or violation of the Library's Code of Conduct, stored images may be shared with staff library-wide. Shared images may remain posted in restricted staff areas as long as the ban is in effect.

The Library Director may release a still shot or portions of recorded footage to the police when requesting their assistance to assess a security risk or investigate a crime on Library premises. Otherwise, requests for access by the Lawrence Police Department or any other outside agency will only be allowed upon presentation of a valid subpoena or court order, or when otherwise required by law. All requests for access to footage must be referred to the Library Director.
