#### Call to Order

David called the meeting to order at 4:30 p.m.

#### Public Comment

There were no public comments.

#### Consent Agenda

Judy moved to accept the consent agenda; Kevan seconded. All in favor; motion carried.

#### Director's Report

Read Across Lawrence/Big Read events have been going well and we are looking forward to seeing Julia Alvarez on March 5. Board members are invited to a reception before her talk. Our Book Squad partnered with NEKLS to provide a day-long Readers' Advisory program which drew a large crowd of librarians from the region. A discussion about moving the Greyhound Bus stop to 7th Street by the library will be on the March 7 City Commission agenda. This will cause the loss of 4 metered parking spaces near the library. Brad said he does not anticipate that it will have much effect on us since ridership is low. The city has said there will be a thirty-day escape clause if problems arise. Our winter reading program wrapped up with well over 300 adults, 400 kids, and 31 teens participating.

#### Library Foundation Executive Director's Report

The Foundation fundraiser was a great success with estimated net proceeds of \$34,000. Sponsorships were a big part in that. Baskets accounted for \$7900 of the total. The Foundation has hired Margie Coggins as a part-time Planned Giving Coordinator. She will begin on March 1. Both Margie and Laura Denneler will be leaving the Foundation at the end of their terms. The Foundation is considering new board members to fill their positions. The Harrison family has renewed the Music Storytellers grant, and the Blasers have given another \$10,000 in unrestricted funds.

#### Friends Report

The Friends presented the library with a \$100,000 check at the well-attended volunteer meeting last Saturday. Two new board members will be installed to replace George Gibbs and Sandra Wiechert at the

Friends annual meeting on March 6. The Mary Dalton Murphy Award will be given to Mary Getter who has been very active with children's materials. A group of Friends visited the Topeka Shawnee County Public Library Friends group recently. Amazon sales saw their best month yet in January with over \$7,000 in sales, and the Surprise Sale netted \$1300. On April 15 there will be a media only sale in the auditorium, followed by the annual Spring sale at the end of March.

### The Big Read/Read Across Lawrence 2017

Read Across Lawrence 2017 is in the books. The culminating event, Julia Alvarez on Sunday, March 5, at the Lied Center, drew 500 attendees. Overall, book discussions and other events were well attended across all age groups. Around 300 people attended the all ages wrap up carnival.

### **Greyhound Bus Stop Has Moved to 7th and Vermont**

The Lawrence stop for the Greyhound bus has officially moved to the corner of 7th and Vermont from its current location in front of City Hall. I believe that the City sees this as a temporary solution while Greyhound secures a more permanent location. It has only been a few days, but things seem to be going fine. We had a nice article in the Journal World about it.

### **Mulvane Public Library visit**

I had the pleasure of touring the staff of the Mulvane Public Library around our library on February 17. They have recently moved into a new building and wanted to see how things were going here in Lawrence. Overall, the group was very impressed with the building and its layout.

### **Developing the 2018 Budget**

The recommended budget will be included in the board packet this month for approval. We learned on March 1 that the budget would need to be submitted March 31 which disrupted our typical process and we have had to develop our budget quickly. That said, I think the budget we have developed will work for 2018. More detail in my budget narrative.

### Foundation Director's Report - March 16, 2017

**Endowment Distributions.** At its February meeting, the Foundation board approved 2017 endowment distributions, including its first ever from the unrestricted General Endowment fund. Specific fund distributions, totaling \$60,854.75, are as follows:

Milliken Fund (studio/music): \$1,344.43

Dr. Bob (books for kids): \$2,500

Steiner (storytelling workshop): \$1,500 Creativity Fund (studio): \$1,052.20

Greatest Expectations General Fund (NEH): \$20,590.61

Beach Author Series (NEH): \$13,473.17 Coan Local History Fund (NEH): \$1,078.63 Unrestricted General Endowment: \$19,315.72

**Endowment Transfers.** Also at the February meeting, the Foundation board approved transferring \$29,400 to the Greatest Expectations General Fund (NEH) at DCCF. These were gifts and pledges collected in 2016. In addition, the board authorized a transfer of \$30,021 in unrestricted funds to the Foundation's unrestricted General Endowment Fund.

**Planned Giving.** Margie Coggins started as the Foundation's Planned Giving Coordinator on March 1<sup>st</sup>. She has hit the ground running. Her first accomplishment was to recruit a group of attorneys, accountants, and real estate and trust professionals for the Foundation's Planned Giving Professional Advisory Council. These individual will advise the Foundation on any issues or questions that might arise concerning planned gifts. Margie also has set up several appointments with donors to learn more about their interest making a gift to the library through their estate plan.

**Board appointments.** The Foundation's nominating committee will meet this month to put together a list of new board member and officer candidates. Margie Coggins and Laura Denneler will be leaving the board after nine years of service each. The Foundation board will vote on the final slate at its annual meeting on April 24.

**Music Storytellers Series.** The 2017 Music Storytellers Selection Committee will meet on March 17 to come up with a recommendation for a musician to invite to this year's program. If scheduling allows, the Series will be held in conjunction with the Arts Center's Free State Film Festival in late June. Members of the selection committee are Marlo Angell and Ben Ahlvers from the Arts Center, Derek Kwan from the Lied Center, Mike Logan from the Granada, Jackie Becker from Up to Eleven Productions, and Brad, Kristin and I from LPL.

**Midco Meeting on the Horizon.** I received a call from the community relations director for Wow!, soon to be Midco, Lawrence's new cable system owner. They are interested in refreshing the computer lab as one of their first community projects. This will include providing all new computers. Needless to say, our IT staff is over the moon about this. We will meet with their IT representatives in the coming weeks to work out the details.

### **2018 Library Budget Narrative**

The recommended budget for Lawrence Public Library is \$4,430,000, an increase of \$99,663. Our budget request to the City of Lawrence will be for \$4,131,400, an increase of \$97,663.

Our goals for our 2018 budget are the following:

- No increase in mill levy
- Increased funding of library materials budget
- Increased funding of library maintenance budget
- Approximately 2-3% increase in staff pay

The determination of our budget request to the City anticipates a 4% increase in property tax valuations.
