Call to Order

Kevan called the regular meeting to order at 4:39 p.m.

Public Comment

None.

Consent Agenda

Kevin delayed approval of the consent agenda until later in the meeting when there would be a quorum.

Director's Report

Brad said he had included a new monthly departmental report in the packet this month. He gave talks at both the New Generation Society and the Zodiac Club on September 11, and was honored to be invited to emcee the United Way kickoff. He has continued his meetings with other community organizations who are working on diversity, equity, and inclusion issues. He met with Erica Hill and Verdell Taylor at Lawrence Memorial who are finishing up a plan for LMH that they will share upon completion. He has also been working with Dr. Hamer at KU's Office of Diversity and Equity who is very interested in working with us. He has learned that there is a plan in the works to try to create a diversity training for cultural organization sector institutions which could be a good fit for us. (Sarah and David arrived at 4:45.)

Consent Agenda Approval

Judy moved to approve the consent agenda; David seconded. All in favor; motion carried.

Library Foundation Executive Director's Report

Kathleen said that the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten program launched on September 9 with support from Jeff and Mary Weinberg and the Jedel Family Foundation. Book clubs are also contributing. Work continues on the merger of the Friends and Foundation groups. All three boards are in favor of exploring the merger concept further. Friends will be meeting with volunteers this Saturday to discuss. Quarterly newsletters will go out soon. Assuming no major objections, planning will go back to the steering committee. This is a long-term project that will likely not be done until January 2020. Planning is underway for the After Hours fundraiser that will coincide with Read Across Lawrence in March. Recent major gifts include \$14,500 from the Margie Hildenbrand estate (unrestricted) and \$10,000 from the Simpson Foundation (unrestricted). The Foundation has received Midco's 2018 computer lab sponsorship of \$15,000 which will be used primarily to update teen computers. This amount will be matched by the Foundation this year.

Friends Report

The Friends approved a \$50,000 donation to the library. They also authorized spending up to \$700 for another computer for their Amazon room. They are busy planning for the fall sale. DownHall Books and the Tuesday Book Market are both doing well.

Ongoing Business

Merit Pay Update

Brad said the smaller leadership team is working through the USMPB document. He has been studying the compression issue in preparation for the 2019 budget. We've been reaching out to other libraries to see if they used a consultant, but nothing to report yet. Judy said that we're not committed to a merit pay schedule yet, but are exploring options.

New Business

There was no new business. Brad noted that tomorrow through Thursday, he and Kathleen will be attending the Kansas Leadership Center's "Leadership Edge" training in Kansas City courtesy of a Rotary grant.

Adjournment

Judy moved to adjourn the meeting; Brady seconded. All in favor; motion carried. Meeting adjourned at 5:03 p.m.

Library Director's Report for October 2018

A Month of Trainings

I was away from the library a considerable amount this month attending some excellent training and workshops. On September 18-20, Kathleen and I attended the Kansas Leadership Center Your Leadership Edge training. It was two and a half days of intensive work on the leadership framework KLC has developed centered on adaptive leadership. The training was excellent, and I intend to send more of our coordinators to future training sessions. The takeaway materials are also excellent. Very excited to dig in deeper and get better at the practices of leadership they recommend.

On September 28, I attended the NEKLS Directors Institute. It was a solid day of training highlighted by a good presentation on time management. On October 1, I attended a training provided by Kansas Health Foundation on board governance. I attended this free training thanks to my membership on the United Way board. It was by far the best board governance training I have ever seen. We definitely need to discuss some of these things at a future board meeting or perhaps even a small retreat. I think the board would benefit greatly from some of the things I learned.

Lastly, on October 3 and 4, Karen, Sherri, and I attended a Beyond Diversity training provided by Lawrence Public Schools. This is the required training for all school staff. It was pretty fantastic and gave me a lot to think about when it comes to racial equity. We attended to get a feel for whether this would be good training for our staff as we will have the opportunity to send more staff thanks to the generosity of the school district. I think it would be advisable to send some of our leadership team, but for our own training, I think we could do something more like a half day workshop that would be effective. I plan to talk to the Beyond Diversity trainers and school district administration about whether they would be interested in some kind of four hour workshop for us.

Update on Diversity, Equity, and Inclusion at LPL

My conversation with the KU Office of Diversity and Equity continues. I met with staff there to discuss a potential work study collaboration that would employ students of color at the library. It has some great potential and am excited to see whether we will be able to implement something by Spring 2019 semester.

Additionally, Kathleen and I submitted a grant application to Institute for Museum and Library Services (IMLS) to seek funding for a pilot project for our inclusive internship idea. More information when we hear back about our initial application.

Reports from Coordinators

- New Staff
 - Accounts Jeffrey Bergeron
 - We're currently working to fill the position left vacant by Martha. By shifting a few things around we're going to be able to increase the position's hours from 14 to 20. We've had 26 applications turned in and have interviews scheduled this week.

• New Volunteers

- Marketing Heather Kearns
 - Xian is returning to help out with Google Analytics. She'll help me and Leah go deeper into how the new website is doing and produce reports that will help determine next steps to take in evaluating where we're at and where we need to go. She'll work closely with Leah to get started and then be here a couple days a week for about 4-5 hours total.
- Materials Handling
 - New volunteers are coming on board to assist with shelving holds & other tasks:
 William D. and Ginny H.
- Youth Services
 - Working with Angela to start a family volunteer project of adopting shelves in youth services to shelf read and keep in shape. We plan on promoting this at the National Family Volunteer Day on November 17.

New Collections

- Button Makers for Public Use
 - Two button makers were purchased with Friends Block Grant Funds to make available for use by the public. The details are still being ironed out, but patrons will be able to check them out at the Tech Desk for use in house. Button supplies will be available for purchase too.
- Starlings- Karen Allen
 - We're ALMOST there for Starling Launch. Just need some marketing and we'll be good to go. I'll send an email out to all staff once we're rolling.

• New Software/Hardware

- Beta Test Jeffrey Bergeron & Heather Kearns
 - We've started the Cloud Library Assist and Checkout app beta test with a limited number of staff. There were some significant problems with the way the app was working with our system, so Kim decided to delay pushing the app out to the whole staff. Some of those issues have been corrected and hopefully we'll be asking all LPL staff to take a look at the app soon. Tentatively the app will be released to our patrons for testing later this month.
 - Leah is working closely with Kim to ensure everything is ready to go before we deploy any messaging to staff and our public. We have a lot of it already in place, but are waiting to make sure bibliotheca is ready before we ask people to jump in.
- IT
- 18 new computers for the Teen Zone have been ordered. They will replace computers which have been in use since the library opened.
- Transition to the new Fortigate 200E firewall is complete. All four old Mikrotik routers previously in use have been removed. The new equipment adds extensive functionality and support, especially with regard to security via our subscription to their UTM (unified threat management) service. Further improvements to the network will be ongoing as the configuration is refined. The first target is to establish a staff Wi-Fi network allowing wireless connection to staff network resources.

• New Partnerships

- Youth Services
 - Site Council: Karen Allen has started attending the Site Council meetings for West Middle School and our Teen Librarian Erica Segraves will be attending the meetings for Central. We both have personal interests in these schools, but the majority of our TZ patrons attend these two schools and we thought it would be beneficial to attend.
 - Erica and Karen worked with LMCMS and the Lawrence Police Department to have some Intro to hanging out at the Library field trips for 6th graders from LMCMS this past month. Our goal was to introduce these students to what the library has to offer, some ground rules for hanging out at the library, and a talk with LPD and library staff about how to be safe when you're on your own at the library and downtown. We thought it was great and would like to extend this program to all 5th graders in the spring with some work with the schools.

• New Programs/Series

- Youth Services
 - We kicked off the 1000 Books Before Kindergarten program sponsored by the Jedel Family Fund on September 9. We had a great party and have 252 families signed up and 21 of those families have already completed their first 100 books.
 - We had two new programs for kids this month: Homeschool Book Club and Kids Advisory Board
 - Homeschool Book Club was a request from our homeschool families for a program that helped them build community within their school structures in a neutral place that welcomes all homeschool families. We had 24 at our first meeting and discussed our favorite banned/challenged books, and spoke about the importance of libraries, the freedom of information, and how books are chosen for the library. We're discussing spooky books at our next meeting on 10/12.
 - Kids Advisory Board is a program we put on our strategic plan under the Opportunity heading with this initiative The Library will inspire people to connect more deeply as a community. We had initially thought we would have kids read Advanced Reader Copies of non-fiction for some feedback, but we're having the kids meet monthly to plan a program that they will be putting on themselves as our long term goal in order to give them some more influence to what kinds of activities happen at the library. This also helps us meet our initiative better by having kids work together and connect with the public that will be attending this event. And, this is similar to the way have conduct our Teen Advisory Board in place, which will prep these kids as they graduate to the Teen Zone.
- Readers' Services
 - KCPT (a potential new partner for LPL) and KU Libraries have partnered with us to put on the Great American Read programming that runs from September 11th through October 23rd. KCPT has awarded us up to \$1000 to purchase prizes, decorations and snacks for the Grand Finale episode on October 23rd, which KCPT staff will be attending for the reveal of the America's Best-Loved book.
- Info Services
 - The KU School of Public Administration graciously offered to film our Action
 Civics series, which focused on the roles and responsibilities of local, state, and

federal government, as well as the role of activists and advocacy in shaping government, and ways that citizens can be involved at all levels of government. The series will be posted on the School's YouTube channel following the Kathleen Sebelius event in October.

• Reports on Signature Events

- Kristin Soper While not a signature event, Sarah Smarsh filled up Liberty Hall on September 25th. You can see her (plus cameos from Kathleen, Mary Klayder, and Brad) on C-SPAN Book TV. Her book *Heartland*, at the time of the event, was long listed for the NBA. It has officially also made the short list! This was also the beginning of a great partnership with C-SPAN Book TV. We've already recommended a slew of local authors and locales for them when they come to town later this month. It has been encouraging to send along future author events that they may want to record.
- Youth Services -Hobbit Party and Star Wars Reads Day
 - We had great attendance at these two fandom parties, bringing together community members that love to celebrate libraries, fantasy, and science fiction.

• Continuing Education/Professional Organization Participation

- Marketing Heather + Leah
 - A reminder that we're headed to St. Louis NOV 13-15 for <u>LMCC</u> (Library Marketing and Communications Conference)

• Youth Services

- Karen met with the new MALA director and is working on a spring workshop for children's librarians.
- Many staff members will be attending the Weave a Tale Workshop with Saroj Ghoting (one of the author's of Every Child Ready to Read) and KLA later this month.
- Karen attended the Beyond Diversity workshop facilitated by USD497 with Sherri and Brad last week. It was fantastic.

• Readers' Services

 Polli will be helping to put on the LibraryReads Great Midwest Readers' Advisory Unconference in JoCo and will be gone after lunch on Thursday October 18th and October 19th. So far we have two library staff attending.

• Task Force Reports/Task Force Requests

- Collection Services Pest containment policy and procedure review
 - Brad, Sherri, Amanda, Heather, Jeff, Jon, and Tricia met to review policies and procedures for pest infestations in the library and/or collections. Our current

procedures are working well; looking at expanding our process to include inspection of facilities by trained bedbug sniffing dogs. Also reviewing messaging protocols.

• All Staff Initiatives

 Department of the Month - Social Hours went well and were well received overall. Interesting to note, people attending Tuesday morning seemed to have a better experience than those attending Thursday afternoon. Thursday there were far fewer people (not as good for socializing), and maybe it was just a busier time (folks took off immediately and did not ask questions or stick around). We may have to experiment with alternative times or work out a better distribution.

• Highlight of the Month

- Teen presentations: Erica and Karen presented a lot this past month! Four department of the month presentations, nine presentations for LMCMS 6th graders, and three presentations for the 7th and 8th grade AVID conference at the College and Career Center. We also hosted a visit from some Olathe Public Librarians who are planning a new teen zone. It was a busy month!
- The Great American Read has been an interesting test for getting the community to rally around reading. The programs have had modest attendance, although we've had enough for rousing conversations with our KU facilitators. Our facilitators have loved the events. Our display is always being looked at and folks are taking the reading lists. We are laying groundwork for continued reading conversations with the community, which ties in with Readers Services departmental goals.

Foundation Director's Report – October 11, 2018

- **Before You Check Out Class.** The Library Foundation will host "Estate Planning 101", the newest class in the Before You Check Out series. It is scheduled for Thursday, October 25th at 10 am in the library auditorium. Web Golden has graciously agreed to present this informative session on avoiding the perils and pitfalls of estate planning. He promises that it will not be another dry narrative!
- **BFF.** The Foundation and Friends hosted an after hours "Banned Books, Boas and Deja" program on Saturday evening, September 29th. Approximately 90 adults attended, and 70 of them became Friends members! The mission of the Biblio Friends Foundation (BFF) group is to encourage new people to become engaged with the Friends and Foundation.
- **Margie Hildenbrand bequest.** At its September 24th meeting, the Foundation board voted to endow the \$14,440.01 bequest received from Margie Hildenbrand's estate. The funds will be deposited into the unrestricted endowment account at the Douglas County Community Foundation.
- After Hours at the Library. The Foundation's special events committee met on Monday, September 17th to start planning for the After Hours at the Library fundraiser. The party will take place on Saturday, March 2nd as part of the Read Across Lawrence Program. The committee will meet again on Monday, October 29th.
- Year End Fundraising. On September 20th, members of the Foundation's Fundraising Committee met to outline the end of year fundraising plan. Committee members agreed on a theme of "You Belong Here" that emphasizes the library as an inclusive, educational community center. The recommended schedule is as follows:
 - Week of October 15: Board members email prospective New Chapter Society members to let them know that invitations are in the mail.
 - o October 19: New Chapter Society invitations mailed
 - November 13: Annual Friends/Foundation letter mailed
 - December 11: Email reminder to donors who have not responded with link to online fundraising.
- Building Blocks Planned Giving Conference. Margie Coggins and I attended the Mid America Planned Giving Council's "Building Blocks Planned Giving Conference at the Kauffman Foundation on Friday, September 28th. The sessions addressed what motivates donors to make a planned gift, best approaches for making "asks," marketing planned giving programs, and managing your work/life balance.
- **Midco Grant.** The Library Foundation received MIDCO's 2018 sponsorship payment for the computer lab. The \$15,000 gift will be used to update the teen computers.

Internet Access and Safety Policy

Approved by the Lawrence Public Library Board of Trustees, September 20, 1999. Revised September 21, 2000; August 15, 2001; September 16, 2002; November 18, 2002; November 15, 2004; November 21, 2005; January 20, 2009; and October 13, 2015.

General Statement on Internet Access

Lawrence Public Library (Library) provides public access to the Internet in support of its <u>mission</u> and to affirm its commitment to the principles of intellectual freedom as expressed in the <u>Library Bill of</u> <u>Rights</u>. Public access to the Internet is a fundamental service of the Library and is provided equally to all patrons.

Patron Responsibility

Patrons who use the Library's computers or wireless network to access the Internet will respect the privacy of other users, abide by United States and Kansas laws, particularly those ensuring the safety of minors, and follow the policies of the Library.

Parents and guardians, not Library staff, are responsible for Internet use by their own minor children, including those who visit the Library without a parent or guardian. Children age 9 and under must be accompanied by an adult.

Use of the Library's computers or wireless network to access the Internet constitutes agreement with this policy.

Unacceptable use includes, but is not limited to:

- Accessing or exhibiting visual depictions that are child pornography, harmful to minors, or obscene as defined by the Kansas Children's Internet Protection Act. (K.S.A. Supp. 2013 75-2589)
- Violating individual privacy rights, including unauthorized disclosure, use and dissemination of personal information regarding minors
- Sending harassing messages to other computer users
- Accessing or attempting to access secure data in an unauthorized manner
- Damaging or attempting to damage computer equipment or software
- Interfering with systems operations, integrity, or security
- Violating copyright laws and software licensing agreements

A patron who is observed using a workstation in an unacceptable manner may be subject to:

- Immediate termination of the Internet session
- Suspension of computer use or other Library use privileges
- Notification of appropriate law enforcement officials
- Prosecution

Internet Safety Policy

In compliance with CIPA and the Kansas Children's Internet Protection Act, the Library implements and enforces technology protection measures in an effort to ensure that no minor has access to visual depictions that are child pornography, harmful to minors, or obscene, and to ensure that no person has access to visual depictions that are child pornography or obscene while using a public access computer.

A Library employee may disable a technology protection measure if

- Requested to do so by a library patron who is not a minor, and
- The requested access is for legitimate research or other lawful purpose

Library staff monitor usage of the online computer network through Internet filtering software, observations of Library staff and other users, and other means.

Patrons who are prevented from accessing web sites which they believe should not be blocked may request they be unblocked via the online form available through the Library's Internet filtering software. Staff will examine the site and determine whether it should be unblocked.

Patrons who encounter web sites which they believe should be blocked, but which are not, may submit a request in writing to the Library Director. Requests must include the URL of the site.

Concerns about enforcement of this policy or observed patron behavior which violate this policy will also be submitted in writing to the Library Director, providing as much detail as possible.

The library will inform patrons of the provisions of this policy by making the policy available on the library's website.

Library Rights and Responsibilities

Library staff will not disclose patrons' use of the Library with respect to information sought or received via the Internet except pursuant to a valid court order or subpoena authorized under federal, state or local law, or as a result of unacceptable use as described herein.

Library staff may establish limits on the length and number of sessions allowed and may reserve some Internet workstations for specific uses.

The Library is not responsible for any unauthorized or illegal activity conducted over the Internet using Library equipment.

The Library is not responsible for loss of data, damage or liability that may occur from files or programs downloaded from the Internet.

The Library cannot guarantee that Internet filters will block offensive and/or illegal materials.

Policy review

This policy will be reviewed at least once every three years by the Library Board of Trustees.
