Call to Order

Kevan called the regular meeting to order at 4:30 p.m. and welcomed Mayor Lisa Larsen to her first meeting with the library board.

Public Comment

None.

Consent Agenda

Kevan noted an error in the 2017 YTD total for overdues. Brad noted that there is an additional check in the amount of \$500 for petty cash which will be used for community conversation participants. Judy moved to approve the consent agenda with the noted corrections to the financials; Joan seconded. All in favor; motion carried.

Director's Report

Brad said that despite year-end purchases, the Library was able to buy a 5-year maintenance contract on the sorter which reduces the per year cost significantly. He noted that 2019 salaries were adjusted to address compression issues as described in his written report. Brad announced that Amanda will be leaving the library on February 13 to take a job at the Wolfner Talking Book and Braille Library in Jefferson City. He and the board thanked her for 10 years of service. Brad said that hiring for the United Way Executive Director has been time intensive, but is nearly complete. The top three candidates will give public presentations at the library later this month to which he invited board members to attend.

Library Foundation Executive Director's Report

Kathleen said that the Read Across Lawrence book handout was today. She and Youth Services Coordinator Karen Allen described the books and activities that are planned for this year's RAL. Three books were selected for this year's read: *Sourdough* by Robin Sloan for adults, *A Tangle of Knots* by Lisa Graff for children, and *The Doughnut Fix* by Jessie Janowitz for teens. Copies of the books, funded by

Capitol Federal, were distributed to board members. The After Hours fundraiser on March 2 will tie in to *Sourdough* with a market theme. An art installation featuring Capitol Federal jar openers and words from all three books will be on display in the circulation lobby. Crown Automotive and Burlington Northern Santa Fe are signature sponsors.

Total year-end fundraising for the Foundation totaled \$47,386. There were a total of thirteen new New Chapter Society members added this year. As a way to build recurring members, the foundation has started a "Ten on the Tenth" campaign.

Friends/Foundation merger talks are continuing after taking a holiday hiatus. A group is beginning to work on the governance piece with a goal to have everything available well in front of the Friends Annual meeting in March.

Cathy Hamilton is the new legacy giving coordinator. She started by presenting two Before You Check classes on telling your own story which were full to capacity. The class offered an option to record the story in the Sound+Vision studio. The foundation gave the library \$236,000 last year. They have just received their year-end earnings reports and will report back details next month.

Friends Report

Friends will donate one or two baskets to the library's After Hours fundraiser. Overall, it has been a good fundraising year. The Friends gave the library \$100,000 in 2019 for a total of \$290,000 over the last 3 years.

Ongoing Business

Merit Pay Plan Update

Brad referenced the performance review timeline and copy of the new evaluation form that were distributed in the packet. He will report back in April on how ratings will be assigned and address any remaining concerns about maintaining library culture in a merit pay structure.

New Business

Audit Conflict of Interest Forms

Brad distributed the conflict of interest forms that are to be returned to the auditor.

Budget and Finance Policy Revision

Brad said that since the city has changed auditors and will be using a large multi-national auditing firm he is proposing a change to the Budget and Finance Policy. Joan moved that the sentence directing the library to use the same auditor as the city be removed, and that the following phrase be inserted at the end of the first sentence of paragraph three under the section Expenditure of Library Funds (beginning "The library maintains all banking services at one institution...): "except when the library choses to invest excess funds in the Municipal Investment Pool governed by the State of Kansas Pooled Money Investment Board." David seconded. All in favor; motion carried.

NEKLS Library Development Grant Application Review

Every year the Board is required to certify that the library complies with the NEKLS grant requirements in order to receive the NEKLS Development Grant. This year's grant is for \$90,500, a \$500 increase from last year. Judy moved to certify that the Library complies with the requirements of the NEKLS grant application; David seconded. All in favor; motion carried.

Review of Annual Organizational Calendar

Ursula's and David's terms on the board will expire this year, but both have agreed to serve second terms. Approval from the mayor is pending. Next month is when the budget committee will be formed. Brad will add a review of the Strategic Plan to the calendar for September.

Board Development Review for 2019

The board wants to spend some time this year working on their own development. They asked Brad to look into what options for training are available from NEKLS. Brad said he was aware of other options that could also be good. He will present his findings at next month's board meeting.

Brad has identified an executive coach to work with on his own development and who could conduct the 360-degree review that the board is interested in. Brad has reviewed her resume and statement of work and feels that she would be a good fit. The Board asked Brad to review the proposal with Kevan prior to the next meeting and bring back a proposal to the board next month.

Adjournment

David moved to adjourn the meeting; Ursula seconded. All in favor; motion carried. The meeting adjourned at 5:45.

The next Board meeting will be Monday, February 18 at 4:30 p.m. in Meeting Room A at the library.

Library Director's Report for February 2019

Read Across Lawrence is in Full Swing

Read Across Lawrence has begun. We have handed out all of the copies of all three books – 1,000 of each book. Events will be held for kids, teens, and adults all month, including visits by two of the authors and a Skype talk with the third. Our culminating event with *Sourdough* author Robin Sloan will be held Sunday, March 3, at 2 pm at Liberty Hall. I hope to see you there!

Researching a More Modern Approach to Recruitment

Sherri, Denise, and I have been investigating options to move our job application process online. We have currently seen demos of three solutions, each with different merits. Our decision at this point will be based on whether we want a simple applicant tracking system or a larger HR suite, complete with time sheet tracking and other options. It has been a valuable introduction to cloud-based solutions to HR. I anticipate deciding the solution we want to implement to occur in the next few months.

Public Services Manager Has Resigned

I reported the fact that Amanda McConnell is leaving the library to pursue a new job back home in Missouri. Our plan for now is to leave the position open for a bit to take time to determine how we plan to move forward. I do not anticipate rehiring this position as is. In the interim, Director of Library Operations Sherri Turner will oversee Amanda's duties. I will update the board about how we intend to more forward in the next few months.

Mavis Staples is Coming to Lawrence!

You may recall that we had to cancel our 780s Series event with legendary soul and gospel singer Mavis Staples last April. We struggled to find a date to reschedule for months and assumed that wasn't going to happen. Much to our surprise, her people reached out to us a few weeks about rescheduling the event this August 21st. I am very excited that we were able to make this happen. We will hold the event at Liberty Hall and plan to make our big public announcement next month.

Monthly Departmental Reports February 2019

New Staff

- The Facilities Department has hired Brandi Buzzard as a custodian.
- Readers' Services has completed interviews for the p/t assistant position and will be extending an offer this week.

New Software/Hardware

- Materials Handling: Aaron from IT installed a new app so that Materials Handling staff has a virtual window to the Hy-Vee lockers. We can see if they are currently working and patrons can transact there successfully.
- Materials Handling has submitted custom report requests from SIRSI so that we can
 extend patron's 7-day hold limit and send notices to patrons of the extension of their
 hold pickup time. This will enable us to adjust hold periods for locker breakdowns or
 unexpected library closings.
- Marketing is investigating a new product called Savannah, a powerful platform to help
 libraries manage, measure, and market their organizations. We've been doing peer
 research with other libraries who are using it, have met a few times with the developer,
 CEO, and various LPL leadership folks, and will watch a presentation to BLT from the
 company (Orange Boy) at our next BLT meeting. Here's a great <u>overview</u>. We're pretty
 excited about it and it is super affordable (starting quote is \$4900/year.)
- **Technology:** 12.9" iPad Pro catalogs are in place in the non-fiction stacks. Four standard iPads are now available in the Children's area with a complement of fun and educational apps selected by YS staff and set up by Sean. We have ordered new HP ProLiant Gen10 servers as well as Veeam backup software with 5 years of support for both the servers and Veeam.

New Partnerships

- Karen Allen and Kathleen Morgan met with USD 497 Superintendent Anthony Lewis
 and his staff to discuss partnership opportunities. Dr. Lewis is interested in
 strengthening the partnership with schools for Read Across Lawrence. In addition, he
 would like to explore the possibility of allowing students to use their student IDs as
 library cards. Karen and Kathleen will meet with school district staff on February 22 to
 begin these discussions.
- Ian Stepp, Vanessa Reynaga, Angela Longhurst, and Melissa Fisher Isaacs gave presentations on library services to the Adult Basic Education and ESL classes at USD 497's Adult Learning Center, and signed several students up for library cards. Bill DeWitt, principal of the ALC, is very interested in developing a strong partnership with

the library.

New Programs/Series

- Readers' Services launched Comic Book Book Club in January to focus on Graphic Novels and Comic Books. The books used for the club will all be on Hoopla.
- Readers' Services is working with Dr. Randy Fuller from KU to offer a more classics-based, academic discussion of literature, The Bucket List Book Club, of books that "you meant to read and never got around to". LPL is just acting as support in this book club, Dr. Fuller will choose materials and lead discussions.

Reports on Signature Events

- Read Across Lawrence is in full swing. In addition to offering scores of special programs and activities, the library will host the authors of the three selected books in the coming weeks:
 - Sun, Feb 17: Skype with *Tangle of Knots* author, Lisa Graff, 1:30 pm auditorium
 - Sun, Feb 24: Author talk with Jessie Janowitz, author of *The Doughnut Fix,* 1pm, auditorium
 - o Sun, Mar 3: Robin Sloan, author of *Sourdough*, 2 pm, Liberty Hall
- The LPL Seed Library will launch for its 5th season on February 16th. We're pairing the launch with a CSA Meet and Greet, which aims to connect community members with local farmers.
- Our Read Across Lawrence recipe exchange encourages people to share their favorite recipes online or in-house. One woman saw Erica's (our Teen Librarian) recipe for sweet dumplings on social media and shared progress with us in pictures on Instagram. She made them on a day that schools were closed last week and absolutely loved them!

Task Force Reports/Task Force Requests

- The Collections Diversity & Inclusion task force met and is planning to test the diversity auditing process by auditing the picture books and adult general fiction collections. KU work study students will help with this initiative if hired.
- Collection Services task force is developing a study to measure turnaround on holds service. This study will track turnaround for holds that are available on the shelves.

Highlight of the Month

- The catalogers are coming to the end of a months-long relabeling project in the media collection to increase accessibility. All DVD movies now have title spine labels, and the Foreign Films collection has more inclusive labeling for languages.

Foundation Director's Report – February 15, 2019

- Audit. Mize Houser accountants conducted the annual audit for the Foundation and library on Friday, February 8. It all seemed to go smoothly. The final audit report will be completed in March or April.
- After Hours at the Library. We are on the homestretch as After Hours at the Library approaches! The annual Library Foundation fundraiser is scheduled for Saturday, March 2nd at 7 pm. This casual farmers market-themed event will top off the 2019 read Across Lawrence program. Please be sure to visit www.lplafterhours.com and make your reservations. Some of the highlights:
 - o Robin Sloan, author of Sourdough, will be our special guest.
 - o To date, we have \$20,500 in sponsorships pledged for the event.
 - A total of 14 local restaurants and Farmer's Market vendors will appetizers and desserts. (see complete list at lplafterhours.com.
 - Music will feature jazz pianist Harry Miller in the auditorium, Kuglers Midwestern Bluegrass in the atrium, and Stephanie and Friends flutes and drums in the lobby.
 - Lawrence artist and LPL children's assistant Matt Lord will sketch caricatures of party guests throughout the evening.
 - Our wildly popular basket fundraiser will feature 20 themed baskets donated by local book clubs, businesses and other library supporters. Each basket is valued at \$100 or more and include an autographed Patrick Mahomes jersey, gift certificates from local stores and restaurants, children's books, and a "Cocktail Chemistry Class" from Merchant's. Themed baskets will be on display in the library lobby from Saturday, February 23 through Saturday, March 2 so that members of the public may buy chances to win. Basket tickets are \$2 each or 3 for \$5. Drawings will be held at the After Hours party on the evening of March 2nd. Participants do not have to attend the party to win.
 - The newest addition to the event is our card catalog wine/prize pull. For a \$25 donation, attendees can choose a drawer and win a bottle of wine. Cork and Barrel's "Grape Geek," Jana Curtiss has chosen the wine for us, one of which is a \$50 bottle called "Acumen".
- **Friends and Foundation Merger.** After a holiday hiatus, the Friends and Foundation merger steering committee's work is once again moving forward. We continue to work on the draft governing documents and hope to move forward with a vote of the Friends membership on Saturday, March 9th. If that vote is affirmative, the Foundation Board will consider the merger proposal at its March 25 meeting.
- **Before You Check Out.** The next Before You Check Out program is scheduled for April 16th. Attorney Bill Colby, general counsel for Truman Medical Center, will speak about his experience arguing the first ever "right to die" case heard by the Supreme Court. Cruzan v. Director, Missouri Department of Health was a landmark case decided in 1990 that underscored the importance of advance directives, a document that outlines a person's wishes regarding medical treatment should the person be unable to communicate them to a doctor. The program will be held as part of National Healthcare Decisions Day in partnership with LMH and the Senior Resource Center. LMH will have advance directives and notaries available at the program.

An Argument for Paid Parental Leave

Last November, Governor Jeff Colyer issued an Executive Order on Paid Parental Leave for State of Kansas employees. Under this executive order, primary caregivers receive six weeks and secondary caregivers receive three weeks of paid leave.

"I think this is an important initiative for all Kansans," said Governor Colyer. "It shows how important our children are to us and how much we value family here in Kansas. I want state employees to have the same type of benefits that you see in private businesses across our state and nation; and I encourage all other statewide elected officials and agencies to adopt comparable policies for their employees."

In the spirit of this executive order, I recommend that Lawrence Public Library offer paid parental leave to our staff. In addition to the State of Kansas, several states, counties, and municipalities provide this type of leave.² A recent article in Bloomberg stated that all of the 20 largest companies in the United States provide some type of paid parental leave.³

Benefits like time off for major life events such as having a child help us retain staff, especially in a public library where pay is modest compared to other occupations. Paid parental leave would send a strong message to our staff that their lives matter to the leaders of this library.

Figuring out an exact annual cost estimate for providing this benefit is somewhat difficult since the number of new parents we have each year is unpredictable. But to provide an estimate, if a full-time Assistant II employee received paid parental leave as a primary caregiver, and the library needed to replace their hours in their entirety, the cost would be roughly \$5,000. I suggest we set aside funding in the salary and wages budget line each year in anticipation of potential costs associated with providing this benefit. It is crucial that we make sure that we do not place undue burden on other staff during the new parent's absence.

My recommendation is to provide **eight weeks of paid parental leave** following the birth or adoption of a child. This leave would run concurrently with FMLA leave. Employees would receive 100 percent of their regular salary during their leave. To implement this change, we would need to revise the Time Off Benefits of our current Employee Handbook.
