

Community Bulletin Board Guidelines

PURPOSE

To be a trusted space for Lawrence Public Library visitors to browse job opportunities, free and for-profit services, and find local information about things to do in our community. This space is intended to promote events, services, and community information that has about a 1-2 month shelf life. If your service has no expiration date, it will be removed after 10 days so everyone gets a chance to use the board.

GOALS

- To keep the board organized for ease of browsability
- To maintain the board to ensure that posts are current and date-stamped
- To revisit and assess the guidelines on an annual basis to ensure the board is meeting its intended purpose

SUBMISSION PROCESS

- Bring your submissions to the Welcome Desk in the library's main lobby
- We will review and post if your content meets our guidelines

NUTS & BOLTS

- A typical post cycle lasts 30 days (or until the event expires) beginning from when it gets its date stamp
- It can take between 1-3 days after submission to get your post into the cycle
- Limit 1 post per organization/service/individual per cycle
- Eternal posts (ex: yoga classes with no expiration date) will be removed after 10 days so everyone gets a chance to use the board; resubmission is ok. This space simply can't sustain content that never expires.
- Posts without a date stamp will be removed
- Posts that violate the guidelines will be pulled from submission without notification


Kansas City's voice for LGBT and allied communities. The monthly magazine brings you news, editorials, letters, and community resources.
