Board of Trustees Report

- Brad and Kelly report
- B.A. Green construction has not wrapped yet
- Board was presented with two operational policies: (1) Social Media Policy; and (2)
 Community Bulletin Board Policy

Executive Director's report

- Year-end fundraising was strong
 - Book Sales netted 1% higher than last year
 - o Restricted gifts were down, but we don't budget for these and that's expected
 - \$664,000 total raised
 - Positive gain in investments will be revealed soon
 - New Chapter Society gifts exceeded \$100,000 for the first time!
 - First time gifts were up; likely due to our bookmark campaign that were placed in library holds
- Kathleen joined the Chamber Board and began this week
 - Kathleen and Melissa (Info Services Coordinator) met to discuss opportunities to connect our small business resources with the Chamber's
- Fundraiser planning is well underway! Kathleen presents the invitation graphic.
- Retirement Boot Camp is being rebranded to RetroActive due to a trademark issue.

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Massive Music Sale

- Annamarie reports a remarkable volunteer effort and huge contribution from Kelly Corcoran from Love Garden. Over 8,000 CDs alphabetized and valued!
- Made over \$8.000!
- Most CDs ever sold at once. Formatting it as a music-specific sale seems to have traction.
- If we do it next year, we need to figure out crowd control. Far too many people.
 Head count; one in, one out.
- Committee wishes to present Kelly with a Gold Library Card and a library hat at the annual meeting
- Partnership with AudioReader is also really successful
- Second Saturday sales begin again in February!
- Budget goal is increased modestly

Internet sales

- Stan reports a record December
- Slight decrease from 2022
- Jane gives kudos to the library's cataloging staff donating a full set of encyclopedias

Membership and fundraising

- Board asks to include # of individual donors be added to the dashboard
- After Hours at the Library
 - Sponsorships are further ahead! \$29,500 already; goal of \$40k.
 - There are a handful of outstanding asks
 - Mary reports 4 restaurants confirmed
 - Eldridge, Limestone, Maceli's, Lucky Seb's
 - Haven't heard back from: Fish House, J. Wilson's, Aladdin
 - We will order pizza as well for extra food
 - Brandon suggests Mad Greek
 - Jane suggests reaching out to bakeries for desserts
 - Kevin Willmott and Deja Brooks are our confirmed hosts
 - This year's fund-a-need will raise money for a new "DIY Memory Lab", i.e. a personal digitization stations for scanning slides and transferring tapes
 - Board members asked to sign up to hand address 100 invitations
 - Still looking for a bartender/signature cocktail. Will ask 715 when Restaurant Week ends.
 - Board members will be given real name tags this year!

- Revised December 2023 Financials
 - Reflect year-end balances in DCCF funds
 - Revenue for 2023 was more than \$376,000 on investment accounts, which brings total 2023 revenue over \$1 million! (Note: the total reflects realized and unrealized gains, but we're still celebrating!)
- Cap Fed CD Summary
 - \$101,000 invested currently
 - These accounts serve as a reserve for the Friends & Foundation. They
 were established to diversify the LPLFF holdings, while still providing
 some liquidity.
 - Next CDs mature in June, then July, then February

NEW Business:

- DCCF Statements 4th Qtr, 2023
 - Return was 13.5%
 - Fund balance totaled over \$3.3 million
 - Chip will attend the next board meeting to give his annual update
- 2023-24 endowment/cash distributions
 - According to LPLFF financial procedures, the board can distribute half of the year's gain (\$83,000 this year) to allow the fund to grow. For 2023, that number is much higher than the proposed 4.5% rate (\$60,000).
 - We have \$55k in available cash. Do we use all or some of that cash instead of taking money out of the unrestricted endowment? Joan and Kate say yes.
 - Consensus is to send this \$55k to the library for block grant instead of the unrestricted line; Kathleen will confirm with Brad if we need to make up the

\$5,700 difference. OR if the library needs more money, the board can distribute the full \$83,000.

- An additional \$74,500 in distributions will come from the restricted endowment lines:
 - General Greatest Expectations: \$40,000
 - Beach Author (NEH): \$19,000
 - Coan Local History (NEH): \$0 (current balance is \$8,800
 - Florence Eggert: \$8,000
 - Milliken: \$3,700Dr. Bob: \$2,500
 - Perez Creativity: \$1,300
 - Steiner: \$0 (we are moving funds back to DCCF and will hold out equivalent distribution amount)
- Motion to approve Joan/Kate Approved
- Discussed a draft restricted endowment fund agreement with Jane Hoskinson and Gwyneth Sigmond to create the Mary Ann Stewart Fund for musician stipends at the library.
 - Committee considered protocol for new funds. Should it be taken to the board for approval, or is that unnecessary?
 - Committee members agreed that since the agreement meets all requirements of the Finance Committee's policies and procedures, it would not need a board vote, and instead would be an informational agenda item.
 - Minimum amount for a named fund currently is \$10k. This is consistent with DCCF's policy. Kate suggested that the Committee periodically revisit the question of what our minimum named fund amount should be.

- Contingency Clause (required by LPLFF Gift Policies and Procedures):
 - It is understood by all parties to this agreement that if future circumstances become so altered that the purposes and conditions under which The FUND is established and administered no longer pertain, or become a violation of current law, then the Lawrence Public Library Friends & Foundation, or its successor, may use the income only from this gift for another purpose within Lawrence Public Library that is as nearly as possible in keeping with the donor's original intent.
 - It is further understood that if such an alternate use should ever be deemed necessary and appropriate, then it shall be designated as the Mary Ann Stewart Fund.
 - o In the event that the balance of the fund declines to a point that it becomes impractical or uneconomical to continue administering it as a separate fund, the Lawrence Public Library Friends & Foundation, or its successor, may add the balance to a different fund with a similar purpose or move it into an unrestricted fund account.

RE: Conflict of Interest Policy Revisions

As part of the Board's 2023-24 Friends & Foundation Policy review, I have reviewed the Conflict of Interest Policy. The recommended changes are shown on the marked-up document included here. I also have provided a "clean" version so that you can see what the finalized Conflict of Interest Policy and Procedures will look like.

In general, the updated version represents a simplified version of the original policy and removes procedural language. Specifically, the section of the original policy that outlined the process that the board would follow to determine whether a board member or employee has a conflict of interest is procedure. Accordingly, that language is separated into a Procedures document and the Acknowledgement that board members and employees must sign reflects that they have read and understand both the Policy and Procedures.

I look forward to discussing this final policy update with you at Monday's meeting.

Conflict of Interest Policy

Purpose. The purpose of this Policy is to protect the integrity of the Friends & Foundation's decision-making process. The Policy is adopted by the Friends & Foundation with the knowledge that individuals associated with the organization, either as employees, Board Members, or committee members, have financial, charitable, or civic interests outside of their association with Friends & Foundation. Those interests may, from time to time, present a conflict for these individuals when contemplating action necessary to achieve result in a real or perceived conflict with the stated goals of Friends & Foundation. This Policy is intended to determine the nature of the conflict presented, the obligation of the person who has a potential conflict, and the procedure by which Friends & Foundation addresses and resolves the conflict. to ensure that conflicts are identified and managed so that they do not affect the services, activities or decisions of the Board in representing the goals of the Friends & Foundation.

Definitions. For purposes of this Agreement, the term "Interest" shall mean:

A financial, civic, or charitable relationship to a person or entity with which Friends & Foundation has or expects to engage in a transaction or arrangement. This includes, but is not limited to, ownership, investment, income, or other compensation derived from the person or entity; a position of authority over the person or within the entity; a familial relationship; or other manner of relationship that may reasonably affect the decision-making process of the person acting on behalf of Friends & Foundation.

Each Friends & Foundation employee, Board member and committee member must execute an Acknowledgement of the duty to disclose any actual or perceived conflict of interest when accepting that role. A copy of the form acknowledge and sign the Disclosure of Confidentiality Statement which includes the "Acknowledgment" to be signed, is included in this Policy manual. It shall be the obligation of The Board must retain to obtain executed copies of the Acknowledgment from each person affected by this Policy. The Friends & Foundation Chair shall remind each employee, Board member, and committee member of their obligation to disclose conflicts of interest at the Annual Meeting.

In so executing the Acknowledgment, any person having a potential or actual conflict of interest as set forth in this Conflict of Interest Policy shall disclose the existence and nature of his or her conflict of interest to the Board, the Friends & Foundation Executive, Director, or any Board Member in the event of any act or potential conflict of interest. Any actual or potential conflict of interest arising at a later date must also be so reported. The Board shall thereafter accept such disclosure, investigate the nature of the conflict, and determine by majority vote of the Board — excepting the disclosing individual, whose presence or absence shall not be considered in the determination of whether a quorum is present — whether a conflict of interest does or does not exist. If the vote is in the affirmative, the Board shall carry on the business of Friends & Foundation without participation of the individual possessing the conflict of interest. If it is determined no conflict exists, the disclosing individual may thereafter

participate in the discussion and determination of the business of Friends & Foundation without encumbrance.

If an employee, Board member, or committee member has reasonable cause to believe that an individual has failed to disclose an actual or potential conflict of interest, he/she shall inform the individual of the basis for such belief and afford the individual an opportunity to explain the alleged failure to disclose.

If, after hearing the response of the individual and making such further investigation as may be warranted in the circumstances, the Board or committee determines that the individual has in fact failed to disclose an actual or potential conflict of interest, the Board may seek to cancel the action, if any, taken by the Board in connection with the failure to disclose a conflict of interest, place the proposed action for a revote, and/or take any further action deemed necessary upon a majority vote of the Board. This shall include possible censure, suspension, or dismissal of the individual who has failed to disclose the actual or potential conflict of interest.

All disclosures, discussions, votes, and remedial action, if any, shall be recorded in the same manner as regular minutes of meetings of the Board or any committee.

Adopted by the Lawrence Public Library Friends & Foundation Board on this 26th day of February 2024. Next review will be February 2027.

Protection of this confidential information is of great importance to the integrity and reputation of Friends & Foundation and is essential to the continued success of the mission of Friends & Foundation.

- 1. I am an employee, Board member, or committee member of Friends & Foundation.
- 2. I have received a copy of the Conflict of Interest Policy and Procedures and have read and understand the provisions set forth in the Policy them.
- 3. I accept the duty to disclose any actual or potential conflict of interest as set forth in the Policy and Procedures.
